## Question A

## Question C

A1: I think the influence of foreign culture on traditional dishes is beneficial. I prefer culturally adapted dishes such as American sushi to traditional dishes. It is also a good opportunity to learn what culture American people have. For example, avocado sushi tells us that American people are used to eating avocado with rice and soy sauce. (82 words)

A2: Although trying culturally adapted food can be interesting, it is more important to protect traditional food culture. If many people eat culturally adapted food, those who cook dishes in a traditional way may lose their job. To make matters worse, it is difficult to regain tradition once it is lost. In addition, foods made traditionally are likely to be healthier. For example, soy sauce made and sold in some foreign countries may be more likely to have additives, which makes it unhealthy and taste less authentic.
