1. Implementation period

3. Items of medical checkup

Medical examination (including simple hearing), chest X-ray, blood pressure, urinary (protein / sugar / occult blood), eyesight, height and weight

5. Precautions for medical checkup

- a. Please fill in the necessary information such as your name on the "Health Examination Sheet" and "Urinalysis Bag".
- b. In urinalysis and blood pressure measurement, abnormal values may occur due to lack of sleep or excessive exercise, so please spend the day before and the day of the medical checkup in a normal life. If the day of your visit is during your menstruation period, please take a medical checkup on another faculty's schedule.
- c. A chest x-ray is done to check for tuberculosis and other chest abnormalities. If you are pregnant or may become pregnant, you can omit the chest X-ray, so please be sure to apply at the reception.
- d. Be sure to wear a mask when visiting the venue.
- e. We will check your physical condition and measure the body temperature near the entrance of the venue.
If there are no health problems, we will guide you to the reception, but if you are in poor physical condition or your body temperature is 37.5°C or higher, you will not be able to take a medical checkup.
- f. In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, we will limit the number of people who can enter the inspection site, so if it is too crowded, you may be asked to return home. If you cannot take the examination on the designated schedule, please take it on another faculty's schedule.
- g. In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, download and use the Hokkaido COVID-19 Tracking System and COVID-19 Contact-Confirming Application (COCOA).
- h. In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, leave the venue as soon as you would finish your medical checkup.
