UMAP-COIL JOINT HONORS PROGRAM: PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Over the course of eight weeks, 16 students from six different countries (Japan, USA, Taiwan, Thailand, Malaysia, Philippines) participated in the UMAP-COIL Joint Honors Program from July 1 to August 23, 2019. The program was comprised of a three-week pre-mobility COIL (July 1-21, 2019), a one-week onshore seminar orientation (July 27-August 4, 2019) in Osaka hosted by Kansai University, and a three-week cruise (August 4-23, 2019) aboard the Peace Boat.

ULY 2, 2019

In the first session, students were tasked with researching the 17 SDGs and asked to consider critical issues of their own countries and communities which must be addressed in terms of SDGs by the government, private sectors, and citizens. Taking the assignment one step further, they were also asked to choose one particular goal with which they felt a personal connection to focus on and explain its immortance to the orium.
